AWARD CATEGORIES AND CRITERIA

George R. Henkle Philanthropy and Community Service Award

Presented to a Warren County resident who exhibits enthusiasm, integrity and perseverance beyond the ordinary to help fellow citizens, the community, and the world through selfless giving – be it talent, money, or time.

Emerging Leader in Community Service Award

Presented to a Warren County resident who –

- Has recently emerged as a leader in community service
- Has outstanding skills which are generously given
- Demonstrates leadership and inspires others
- Serves as a role model for the next generation of community service volunteers

Outstanding Organization Award

Presented to a Warren County non-profit organization which --

- Has been providing services for at least five years
- Serves as a role model for other organizations in being dedicated to its mission and operating at the highest professional standards
- Has made significant and measurable contributions to enhancing the quality of life in Warren County

Emerging Organization Award

Presented to a Warren County non-profit organization which –

- Has been providing services fewer than five years
- Serves as a role model for other emerging organizations for being dedicated to its mission and for operating at the highest professional standards
- Has already made significant and measurable contributions to enhancing the quality of life in Warren County
